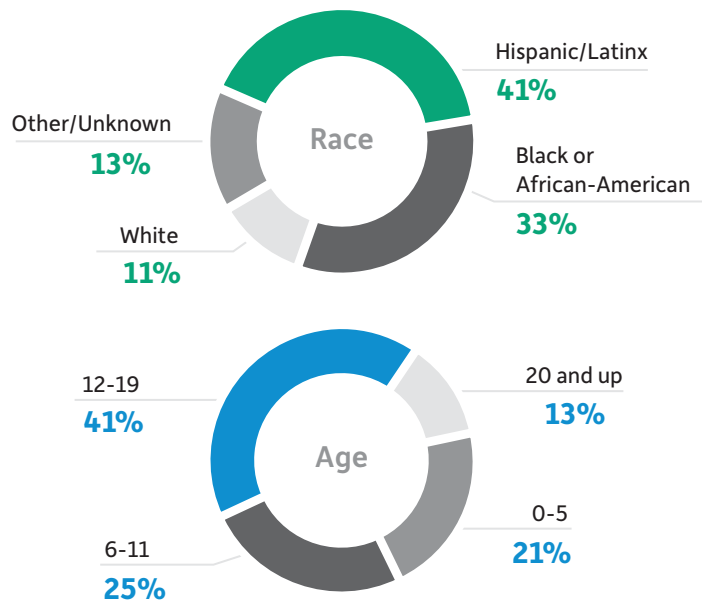

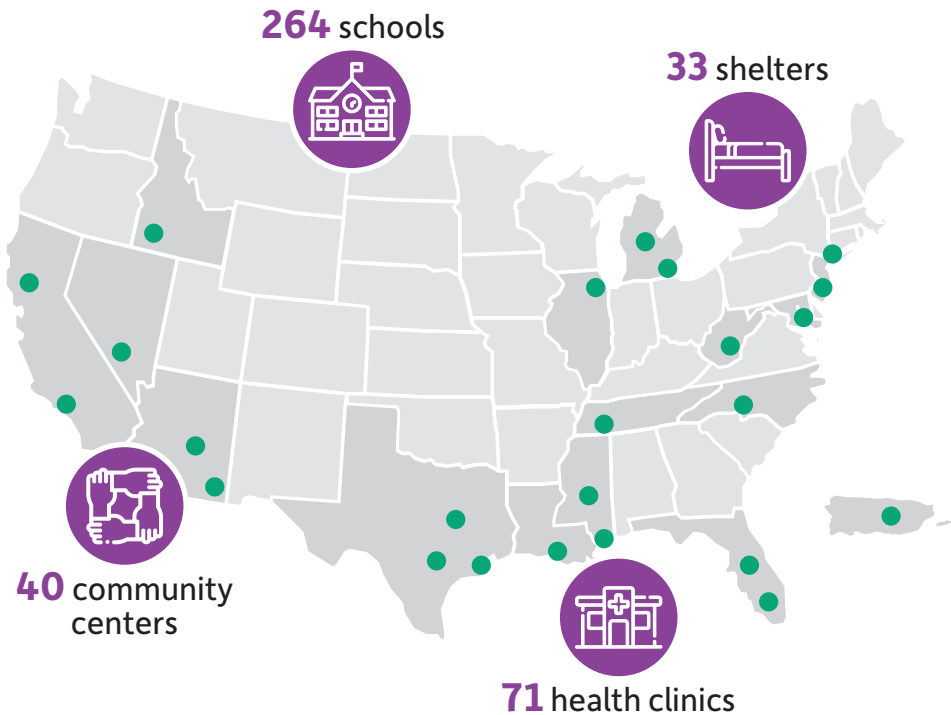
National Network

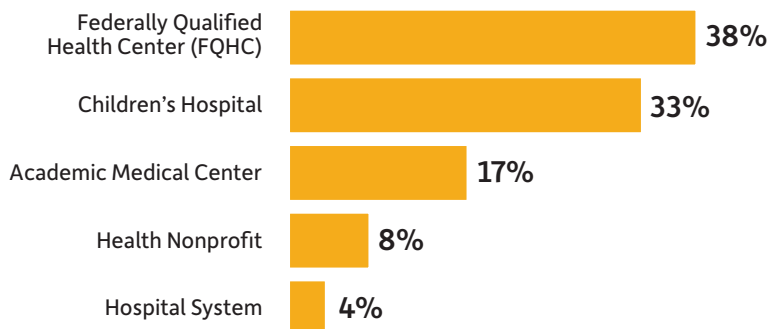
